United States

- Long-term unemployed: 2.104M, decrease of 83,000 since last month (*unemployed for more than 26 weeks*)
- U-6 Unemployment Rate: 10.0% (**U-6: total unemployed (U-3) plus discouraged workers (U-4), plus all other marginally attached workers (U-5), plus total employed part time for economic reasons (U-6)**)
- There are 5.753M job openings (*July 2015 preliminary*). This equates to 1.4 unemployed persons per job opening, or 2.7 persons using the U-6 Unemployment Rate.

Nonfarm jobs: 142.371M (84.5% private, 15.5% public)

- Monthly change: +142,000 (+118,000 private, +24,000 public)
- Largest industry growth: Leisure and hospitality (+35,000), Health care (+34,400), and Professional and business services (+31,000)
- Average monthly job growth (total nonfarm jobs) since September 2014: +229,000
- Compared to September 2007: 4.318M more jobs
The recession began in December 2007

Initial Claims: 263,000

- Weekly change: -13,000
- Annual change: -26,000

Initial Claims: *The count of notices of unemployment requesting a determination of eligibility and entitlement for Unemployment Compensation (UC) benefits. A person can file multiple claims.*

Unemployment Rate by Educational Attainment:

- Less than a high school diploma: 7.9%
- High school diploma: 5.2%
- Some College or Associate Degree: 4.3%
- Bachelor's degree and higher: 2.5%

As educational attainment levels increase, unemployment rates decrease.

- **Nonfarm Jobs:** 5.856M (87.8% private, 12.2% public; annual change: +1.0%)
- **Regular UC Initial Claims:** 66,700 (annual change: +1.8%)
- PA U-6 unemployment rate: 11.4% (*BLS, 2014Q3-2015Q2*)
- There are 224,600 job openings (*Conference Board Help Wanted OnLine (HWOL) dataset for August 2015*). This equates to 1.5 unemployed persons per job opening, or 3.4 persons when considering the U-6 Unemployment Rate.

- **Nonfarm Jobs:** 314,600 (88.8% private, 11.2% public; annual change: +2.8%) (*NSA; includes other counties*)
- **Regular UC Initial Claims:** 1,300 (annual change: +26.7%)
- There are 1,300 online job postings (*Conference Board Help Wanted OnLine (HWOL) dataset for August 2015*). This equates to 4.2 unemployed persons per online job posting, or 9.3 using an estimated U-6 unemployment rate of 12.2%.
