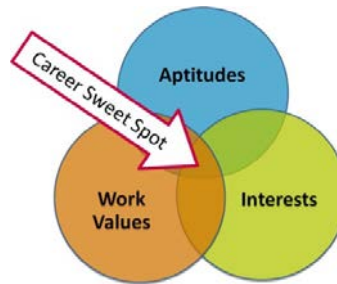

### What is this program?

The Northern Tier Young Adult Program is a federally funded program that provides eligible young adults assistance in achieving academic and employment success.

### What does it do?

- ❖ Assists out-of-school youth (OSY) in obtaining GED
- ❖ Provides year-round education and employment opportunities
- ❖ Assesses barriers for individuals and facilitates in eliminating them

### Who is eligible?
