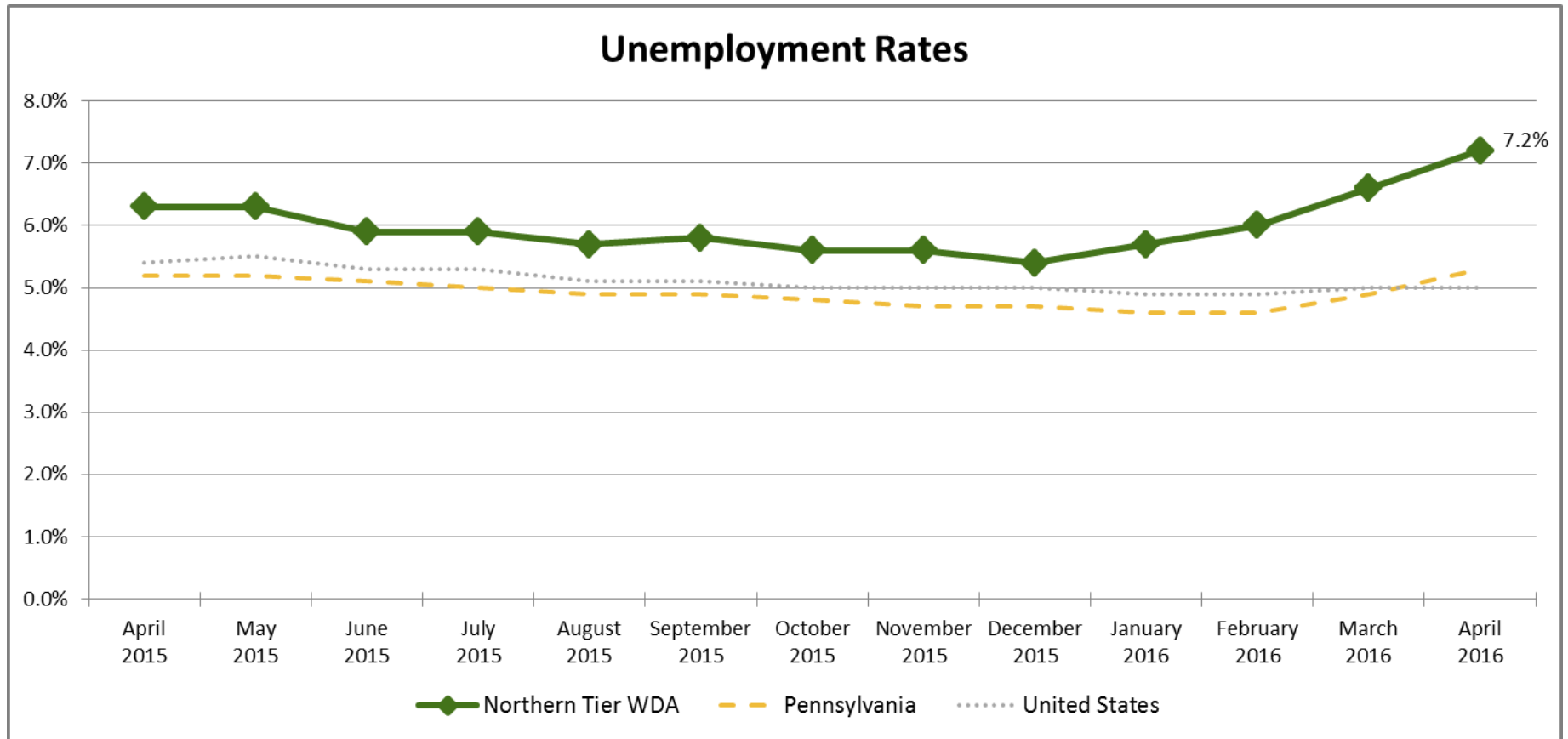

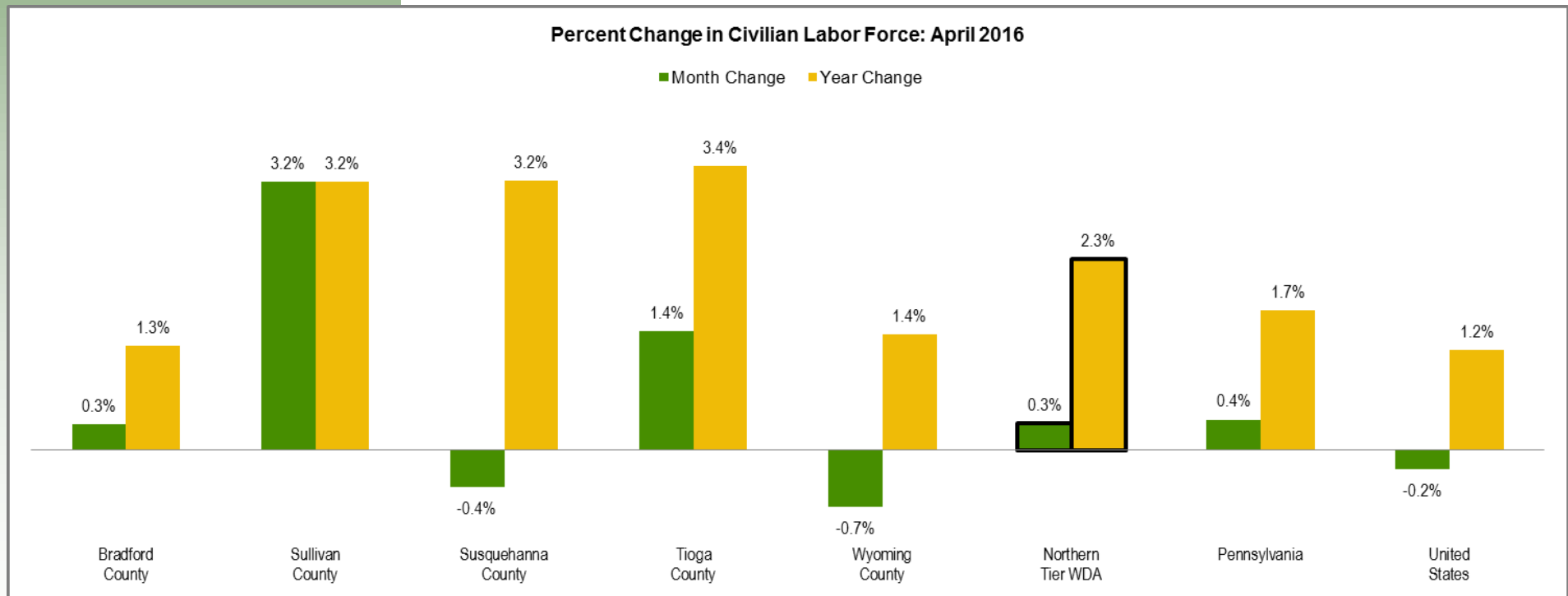


### Civilian Labor Force

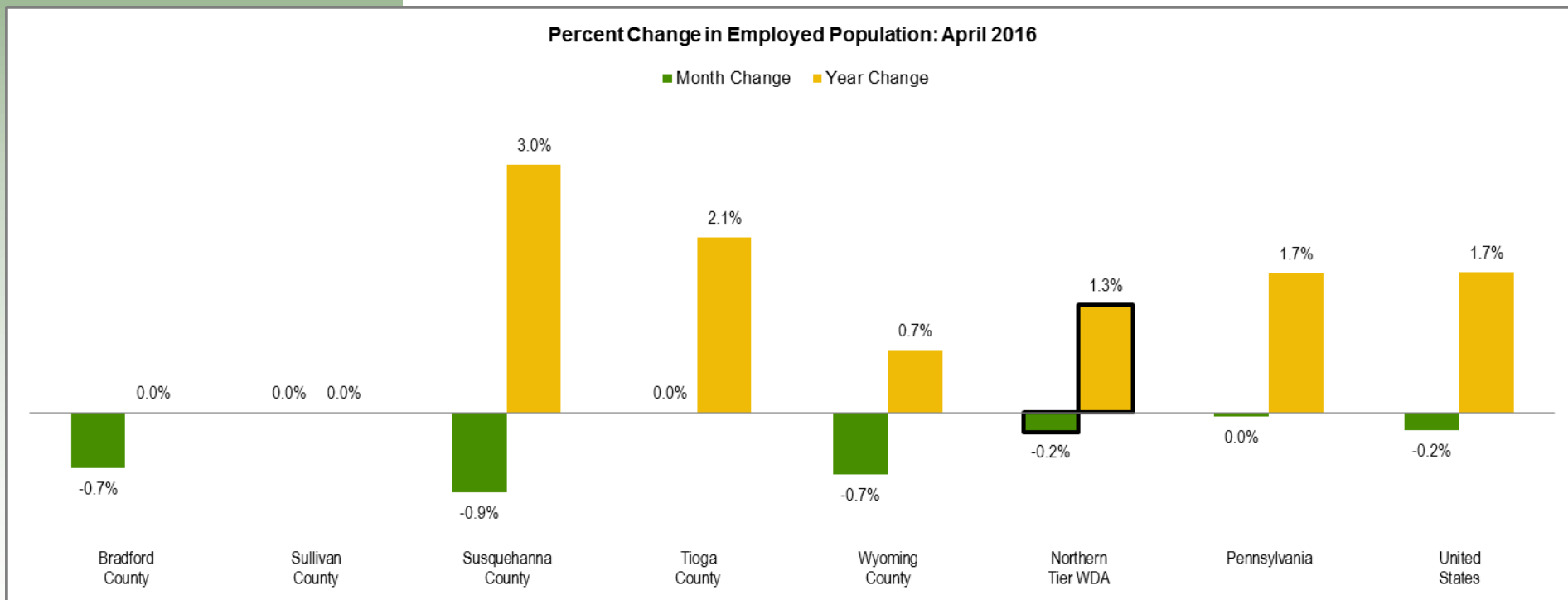

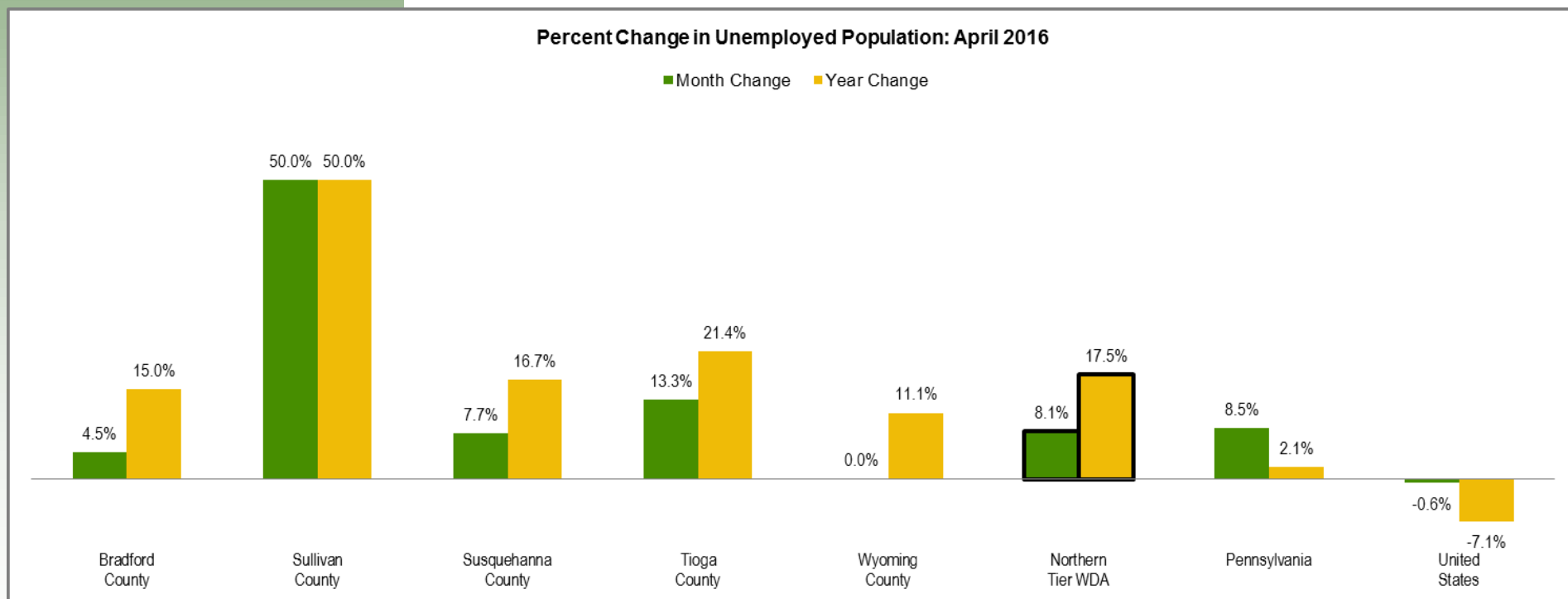


## Unemployed Population
