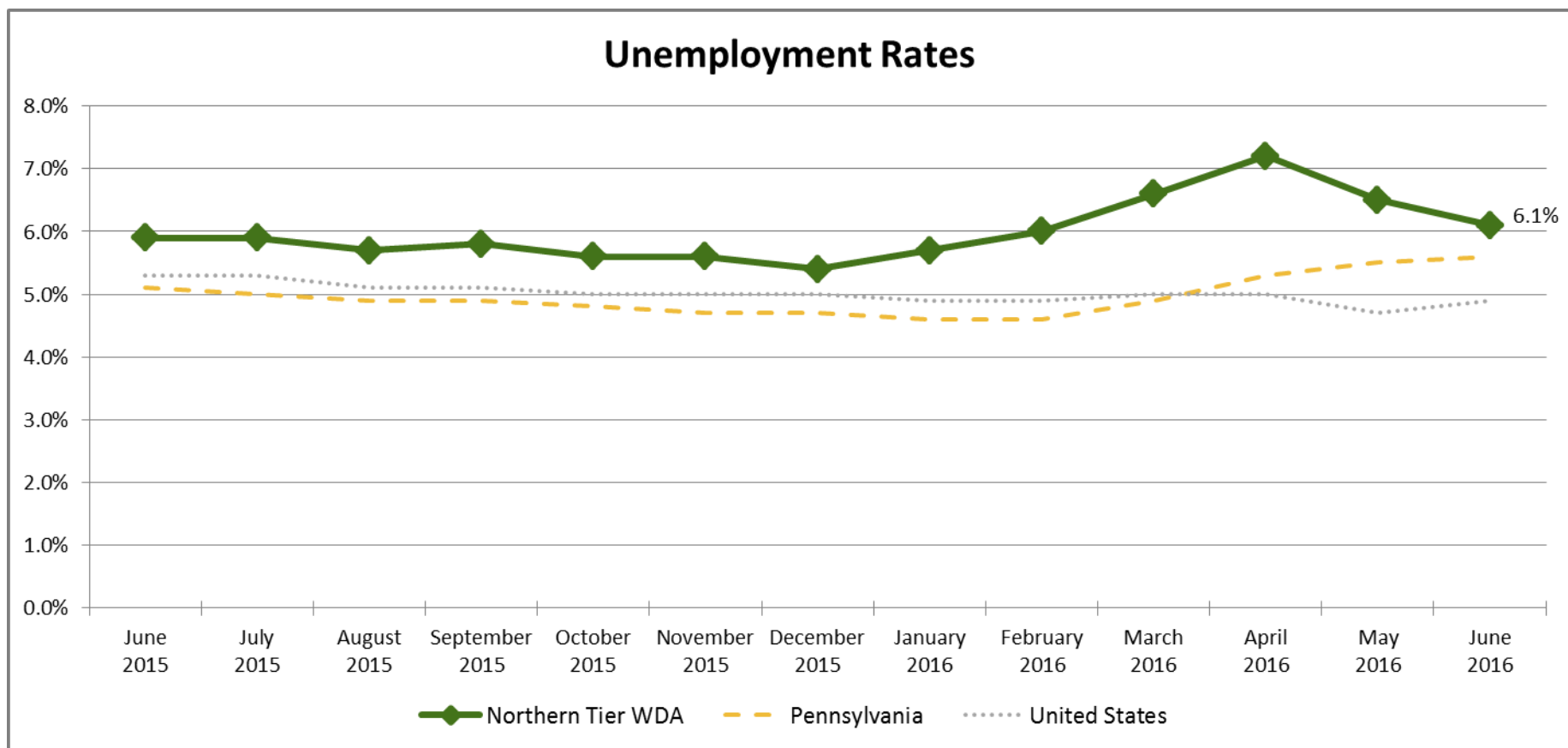

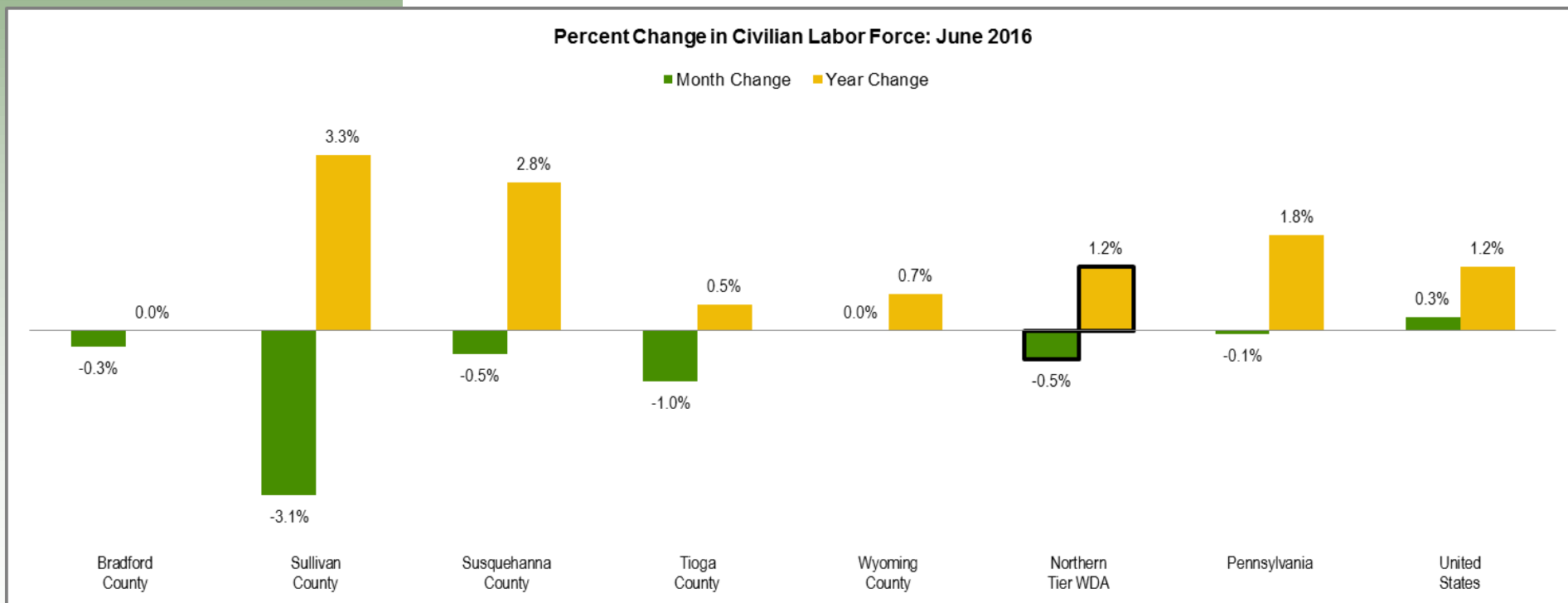


### Civilian Labor Force

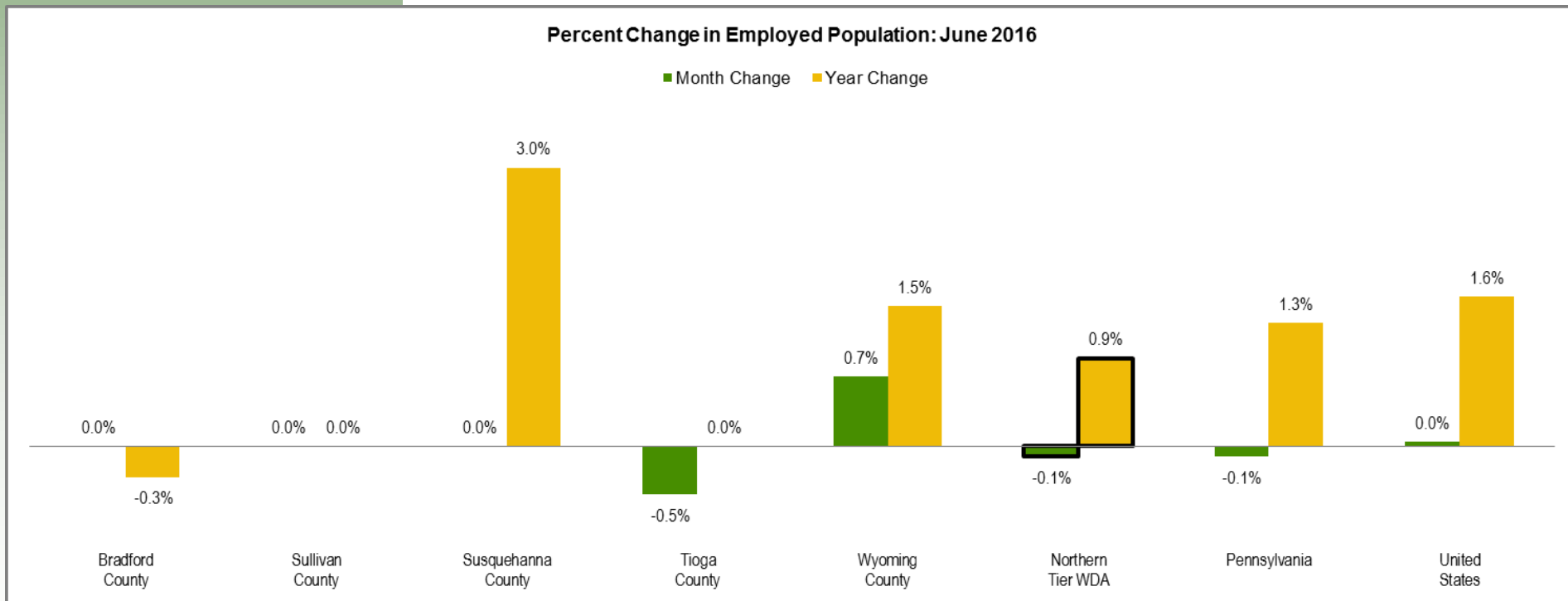


## Employed Population

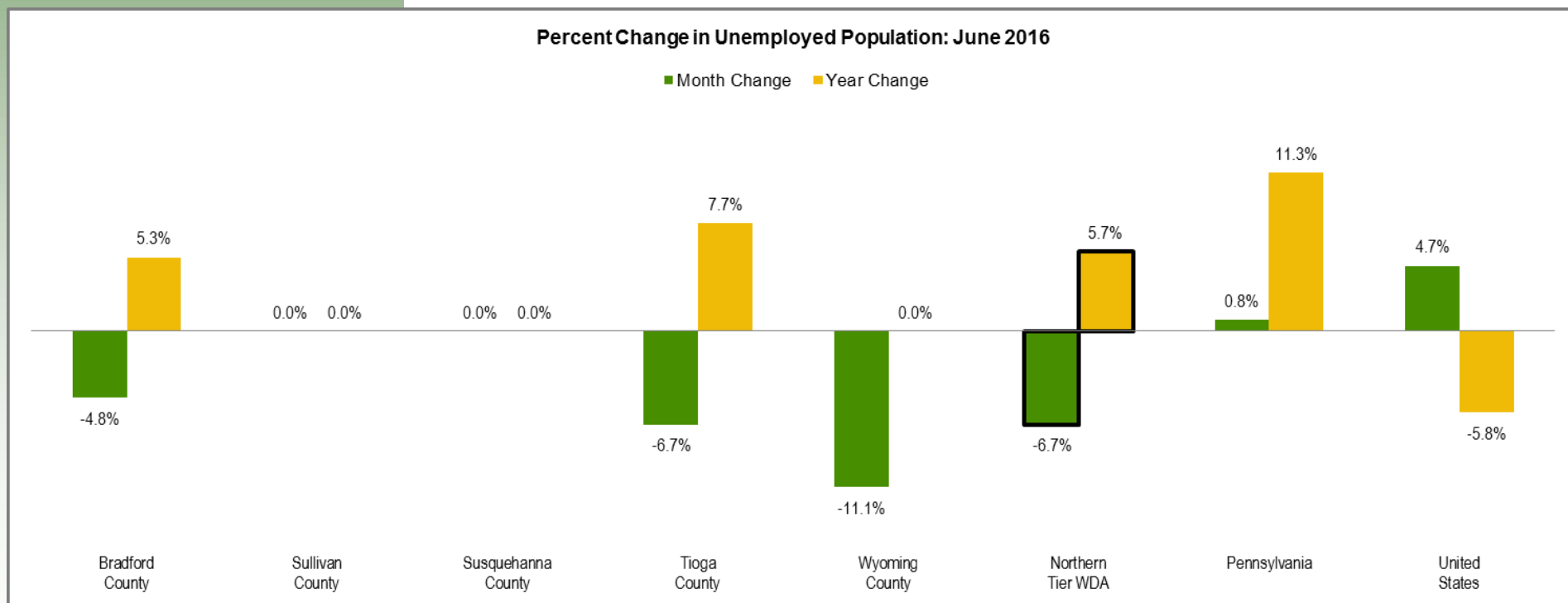


## Unemployed Population
