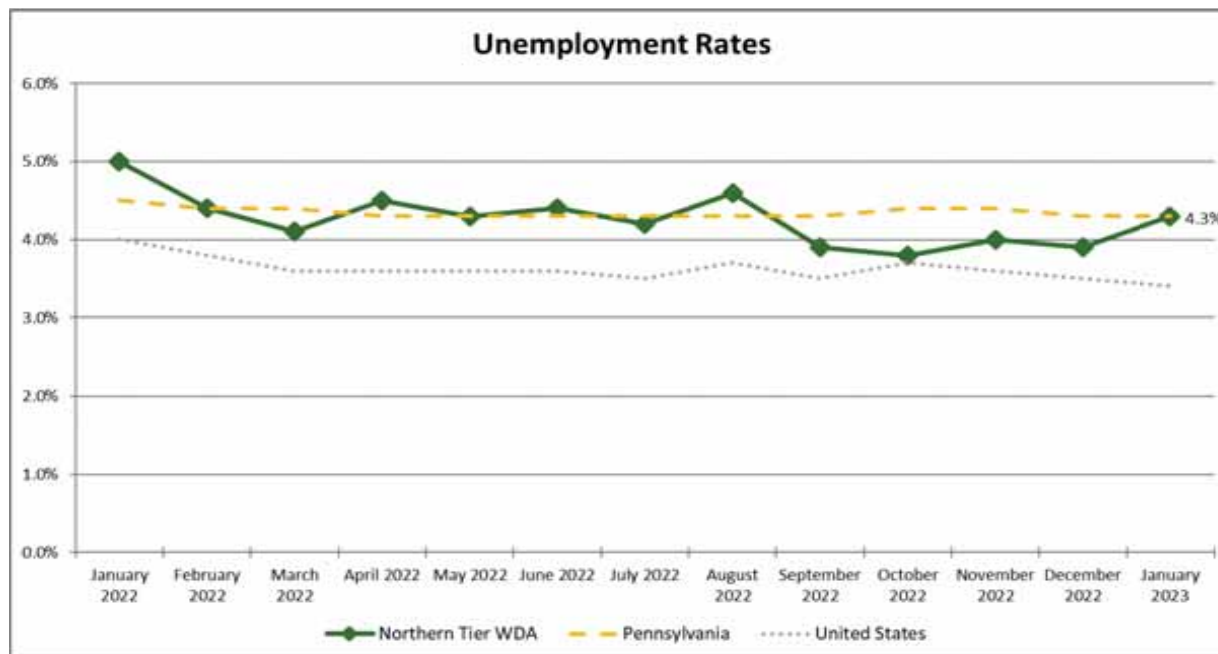

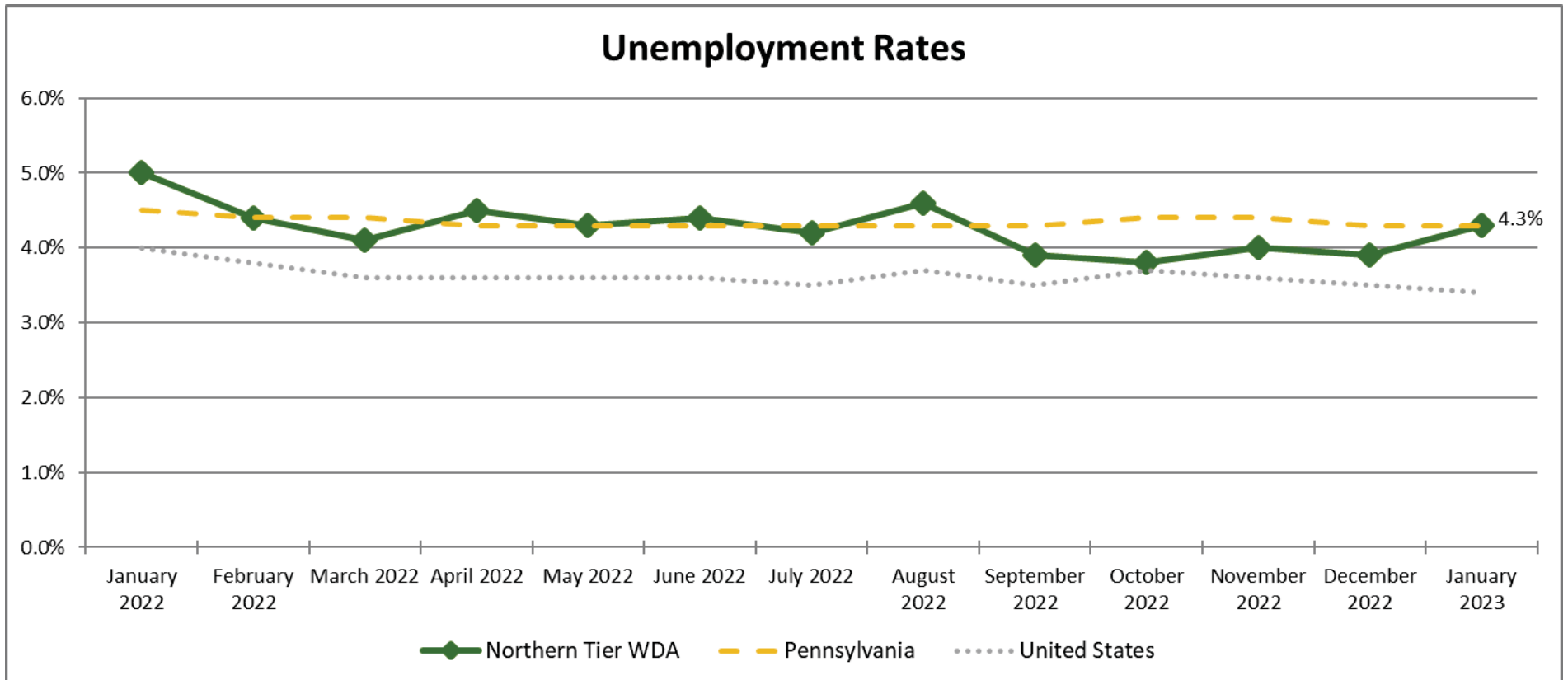

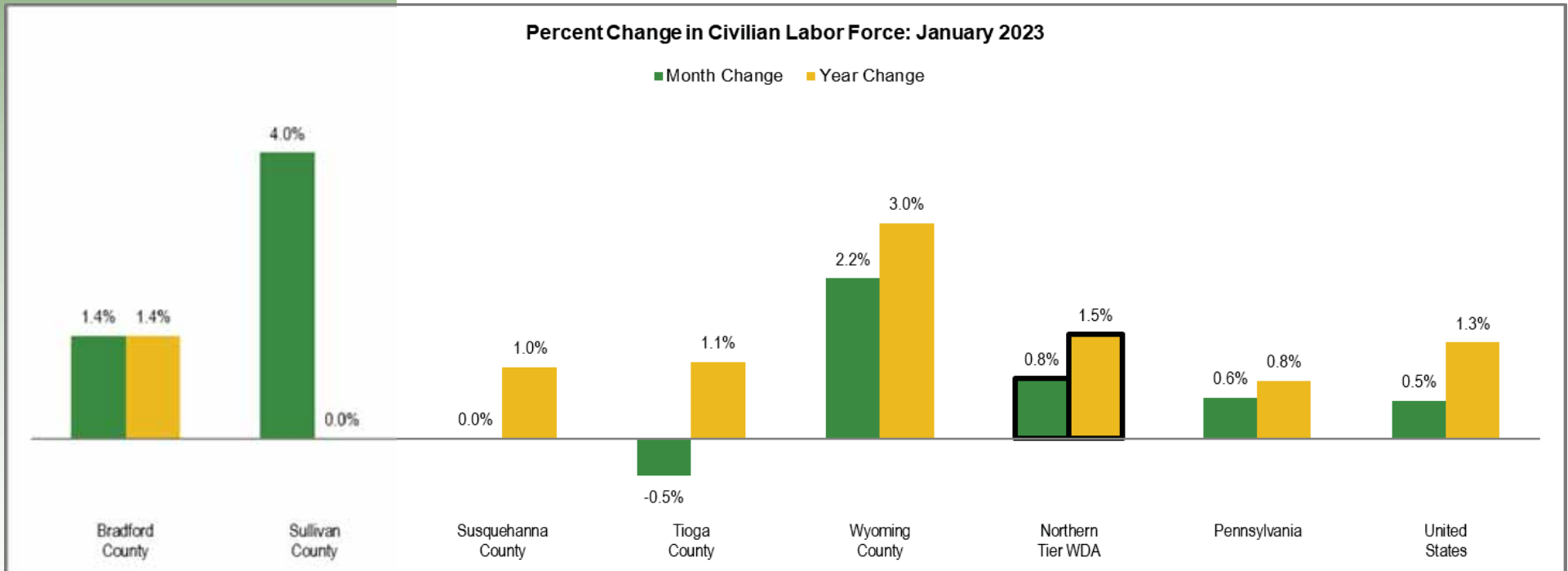


**Civilian Labor Force**

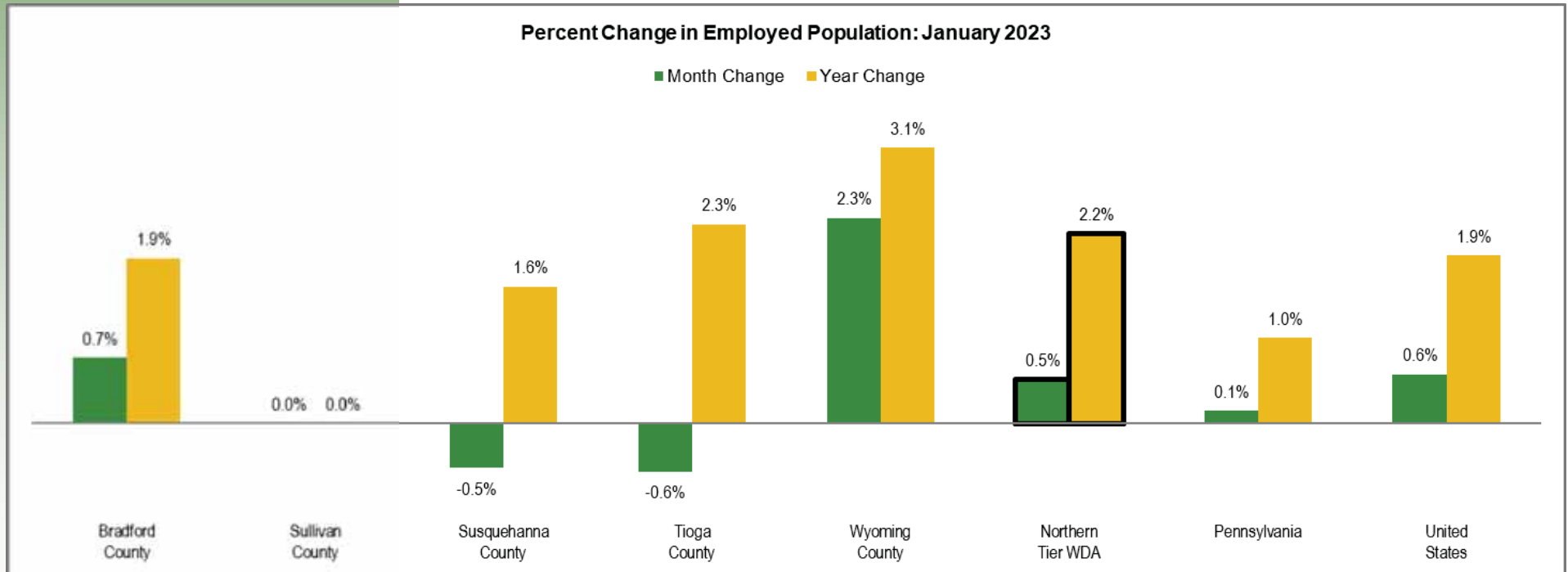

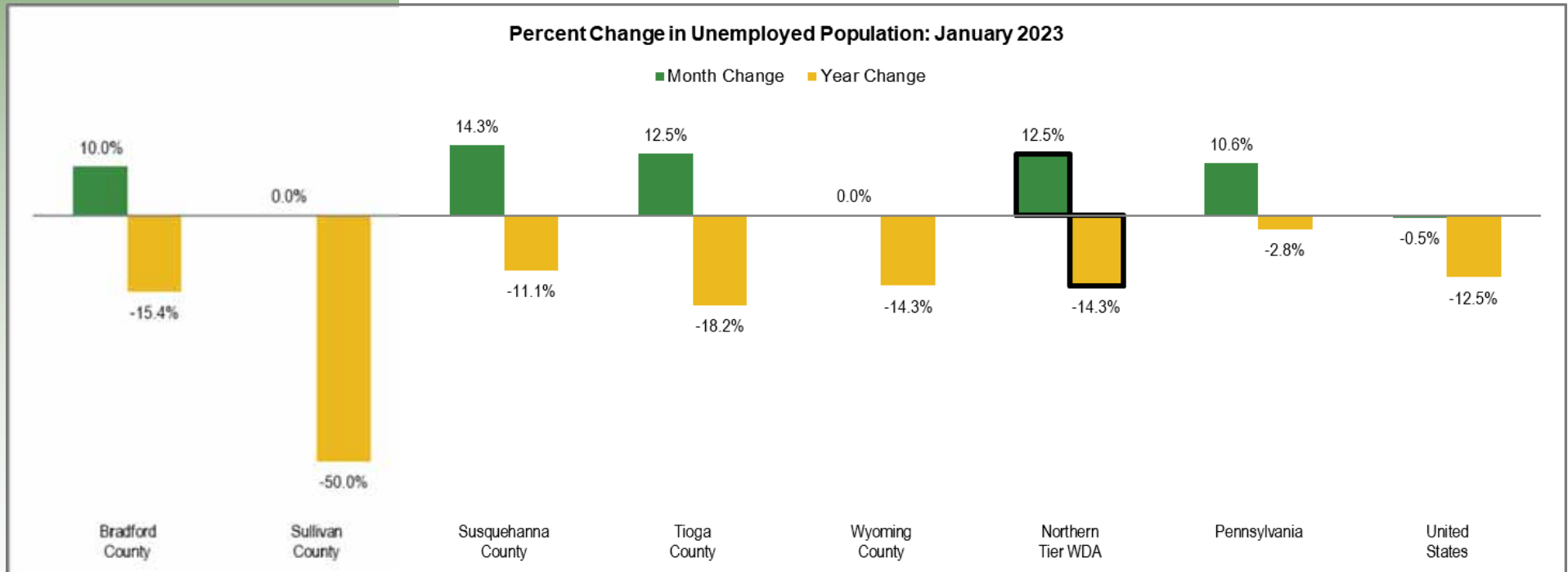


## Unemployed Population
