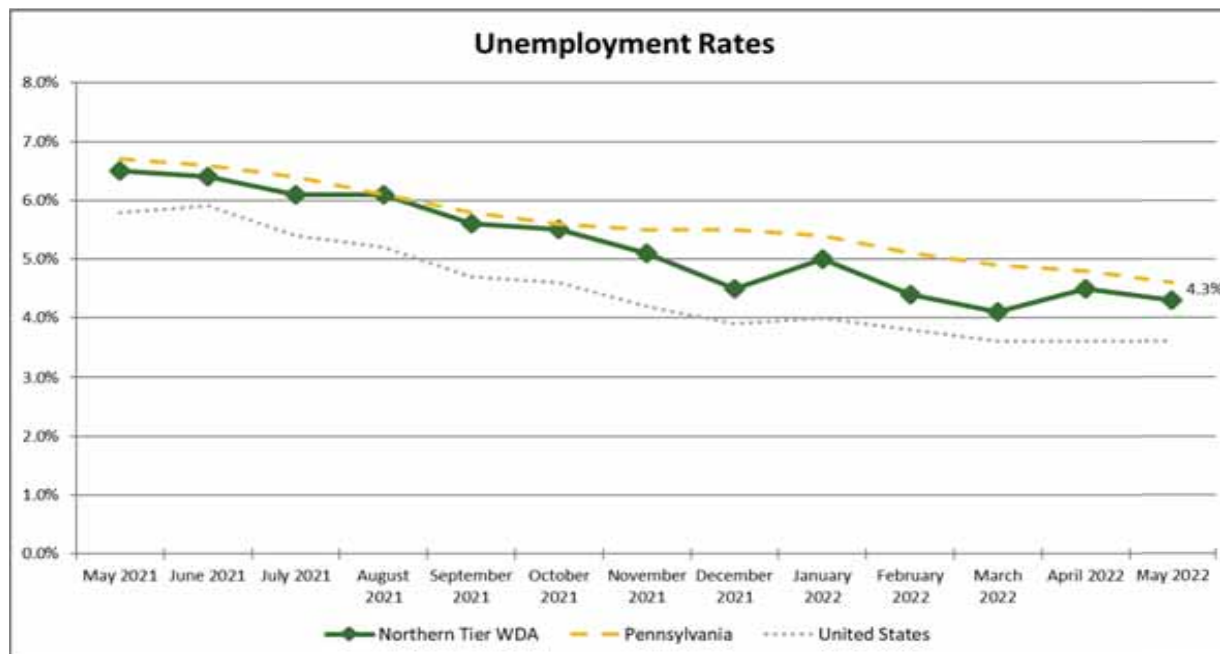

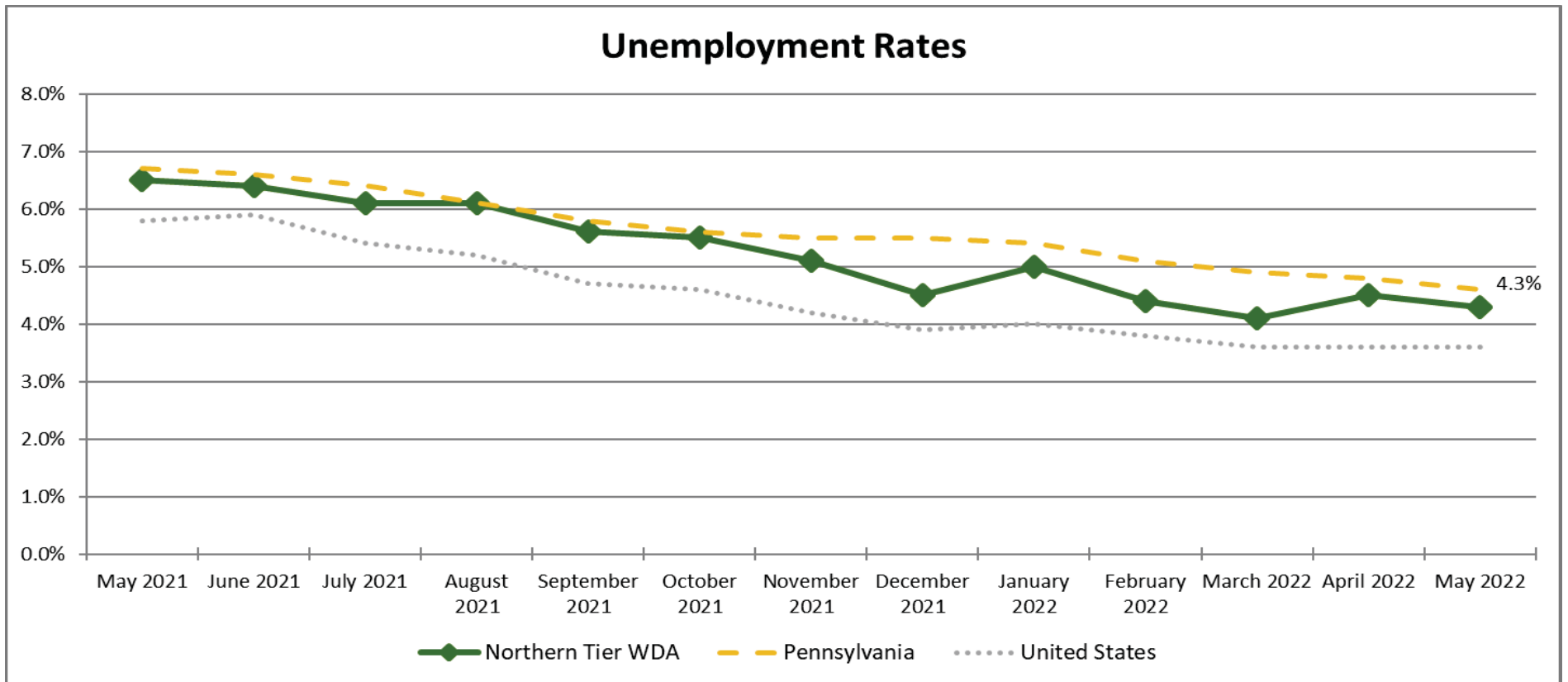

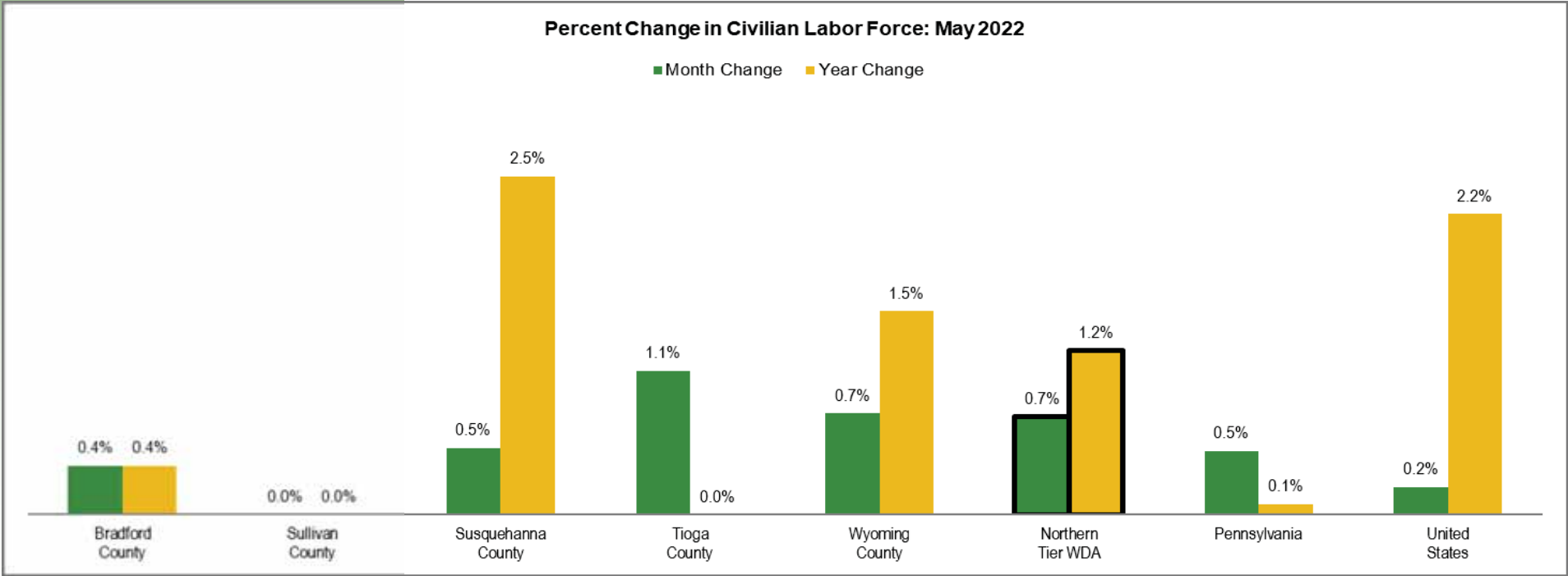


## Civilian Labor Force

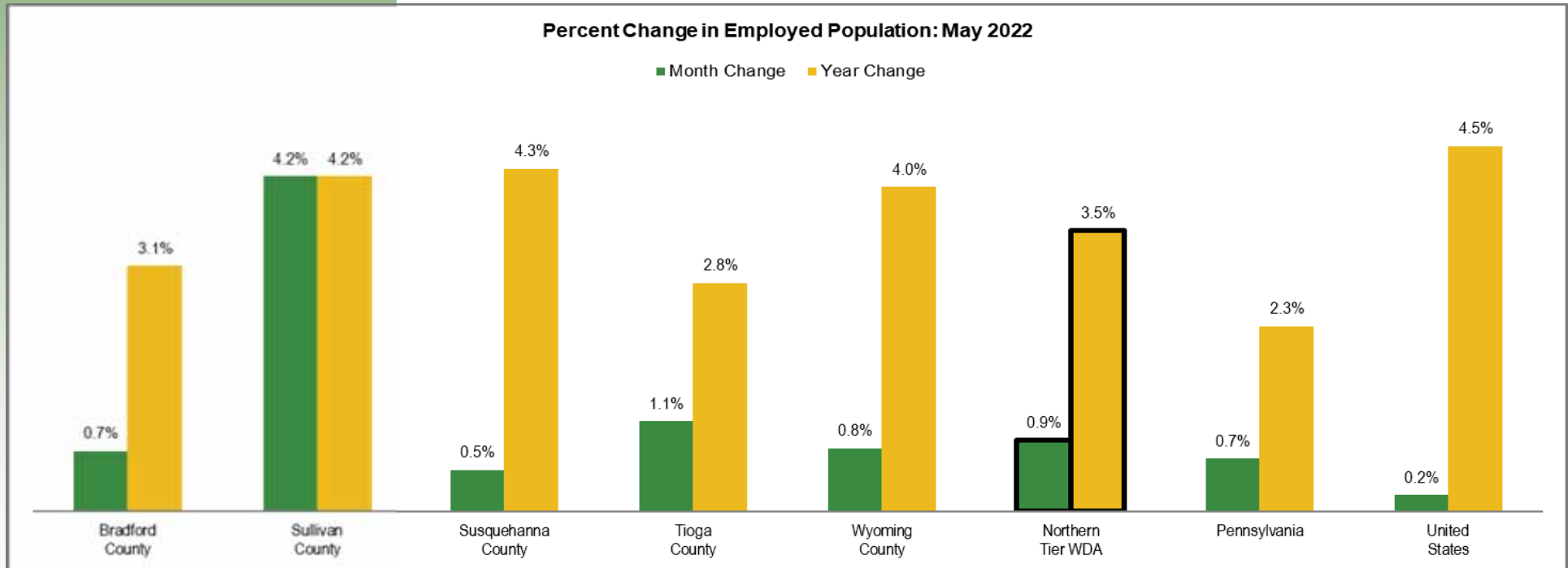

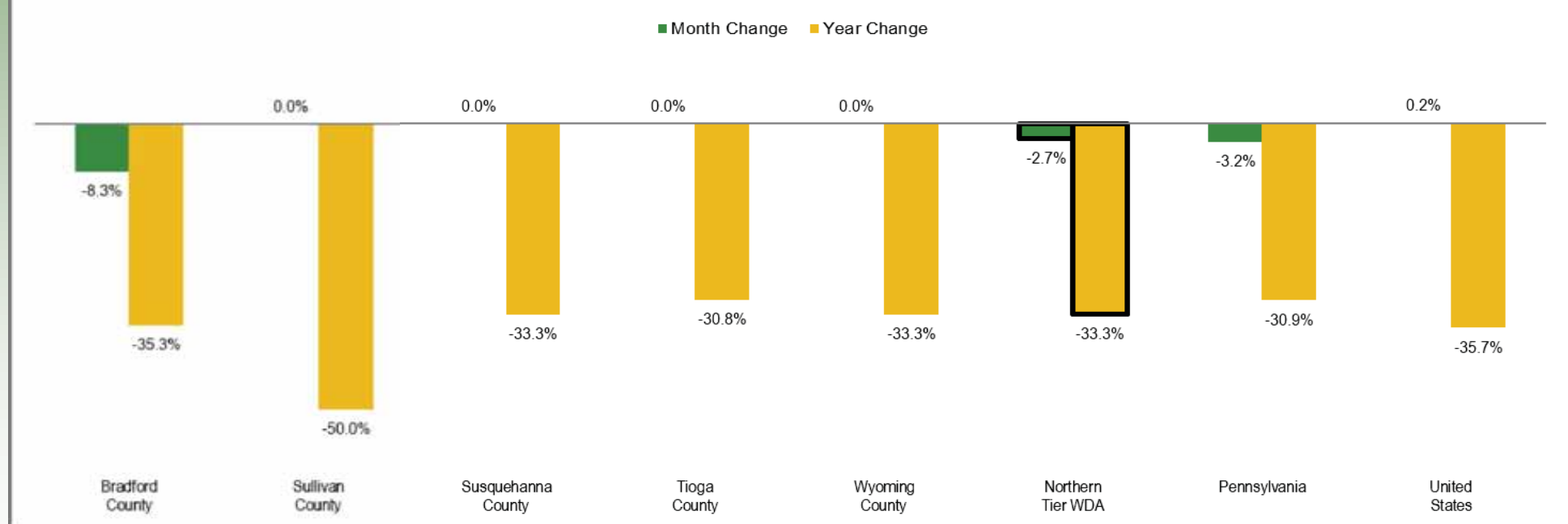
## Unemployed Population
