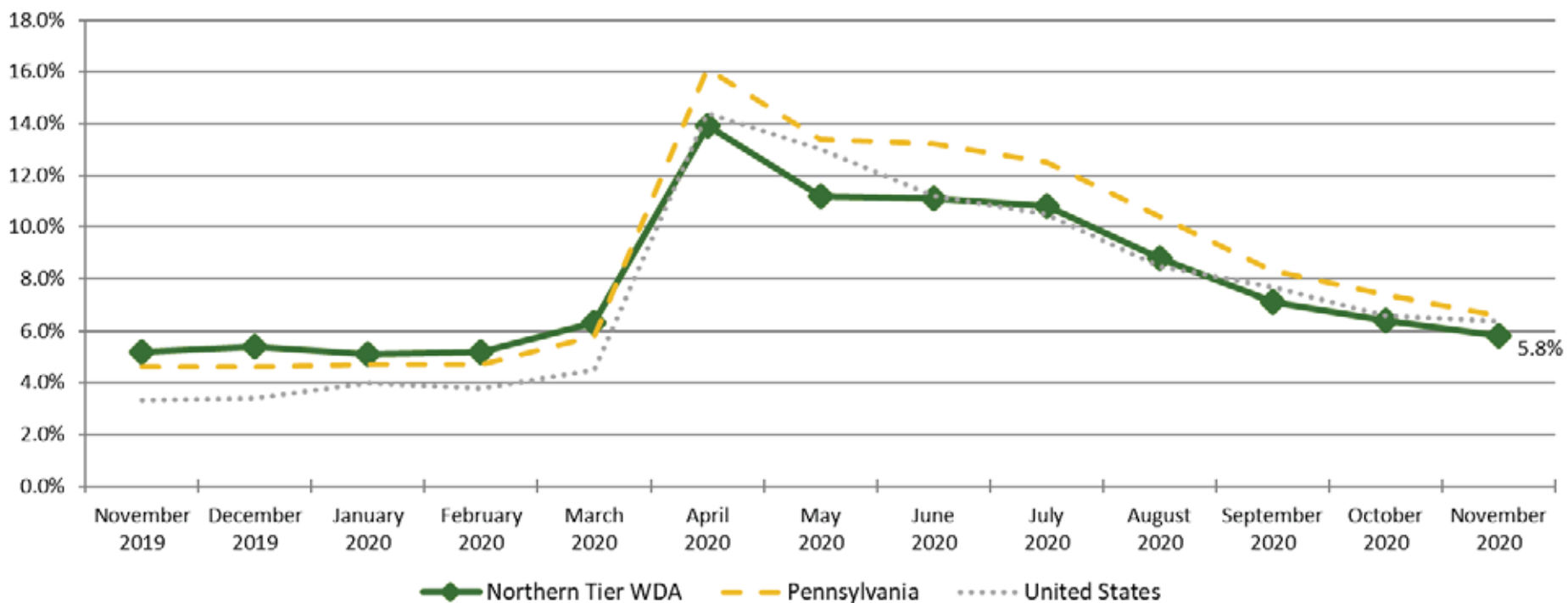

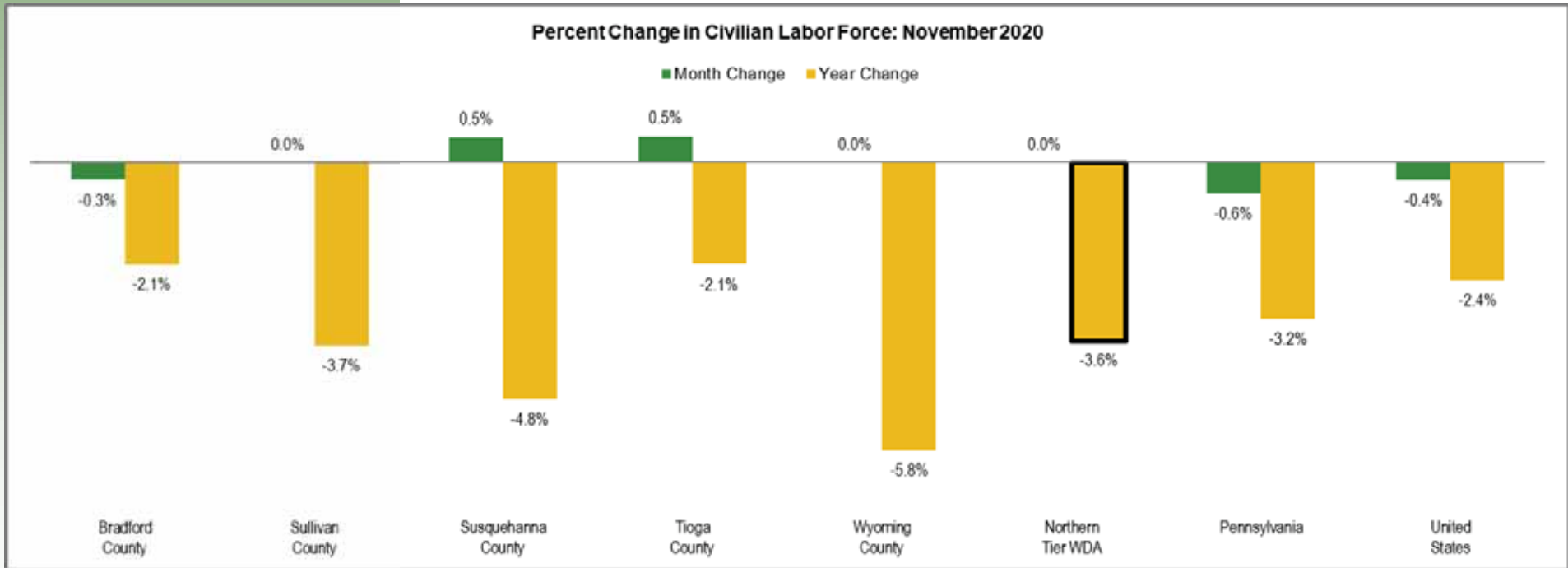


**Civilian Labor Force**

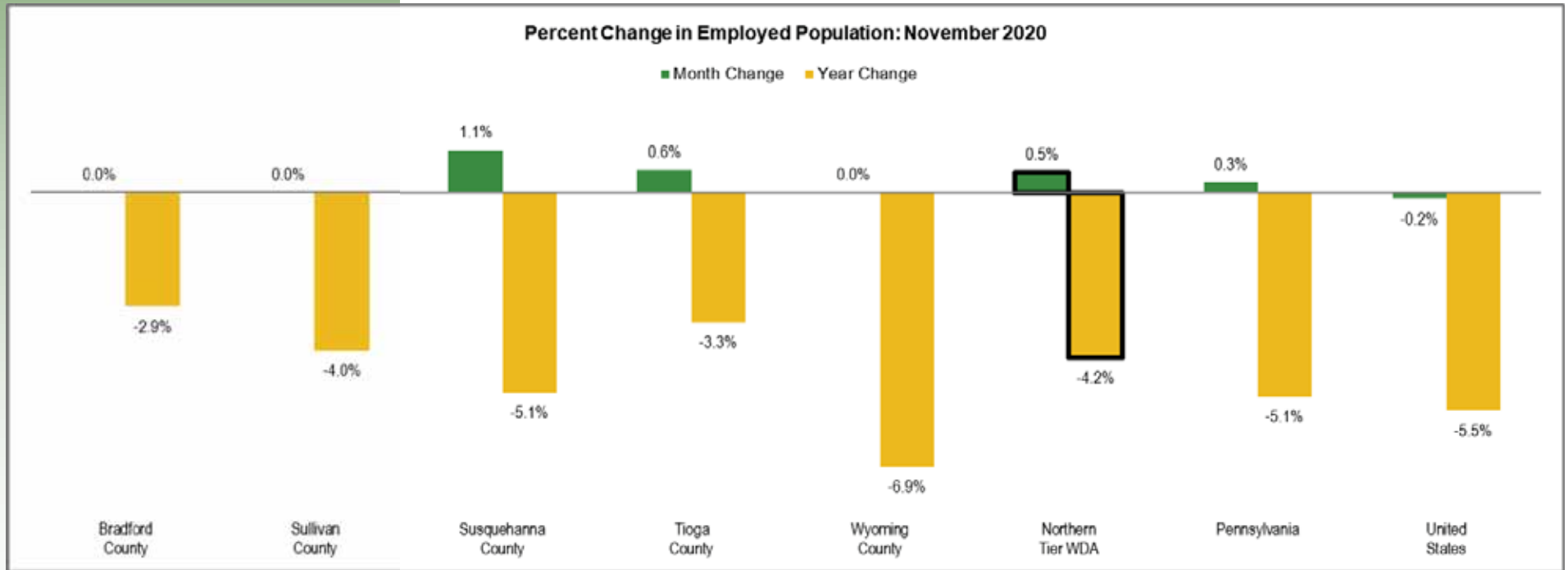

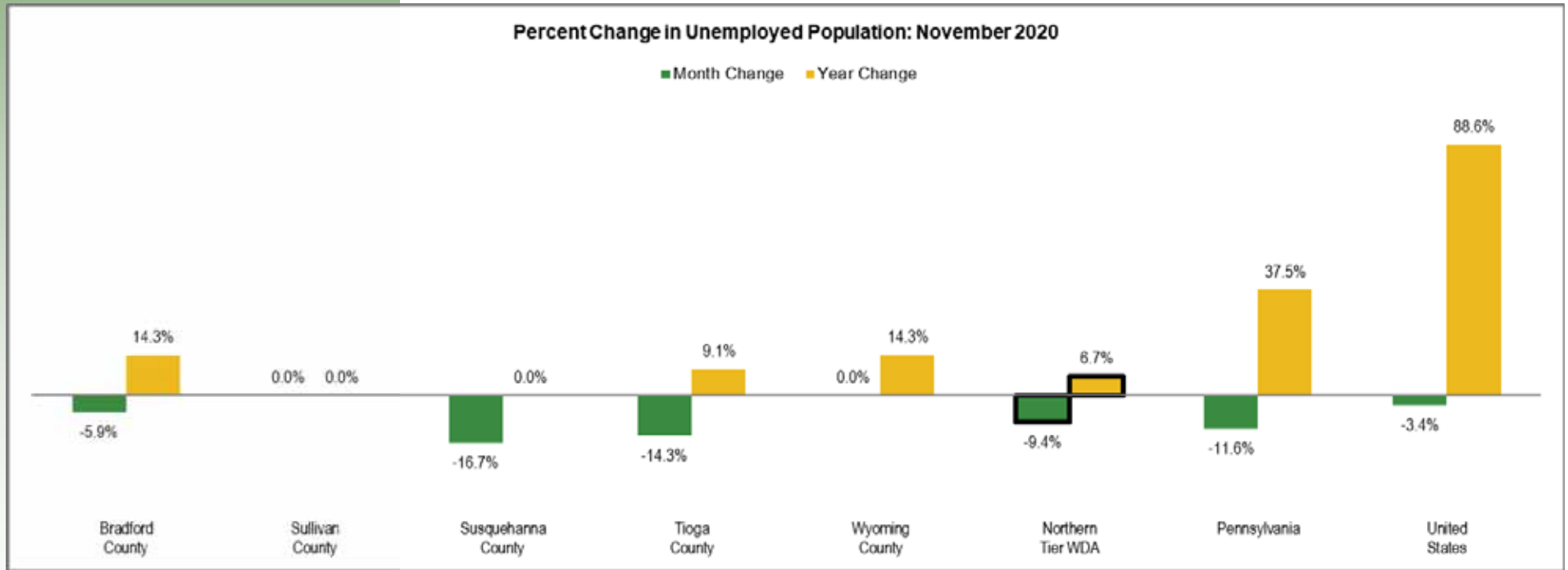
