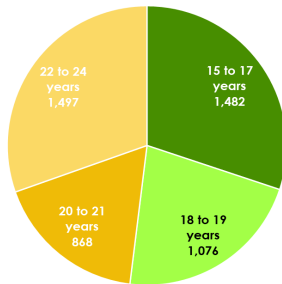

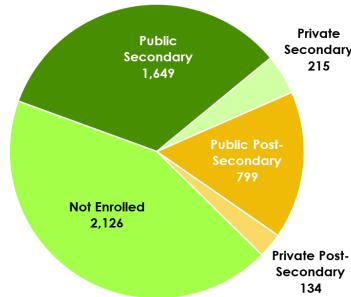

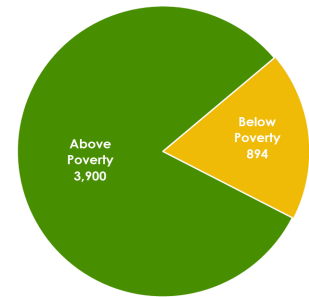
Age Groups
