

Northern Tier WDA Labor Market Report ♦ January 2025

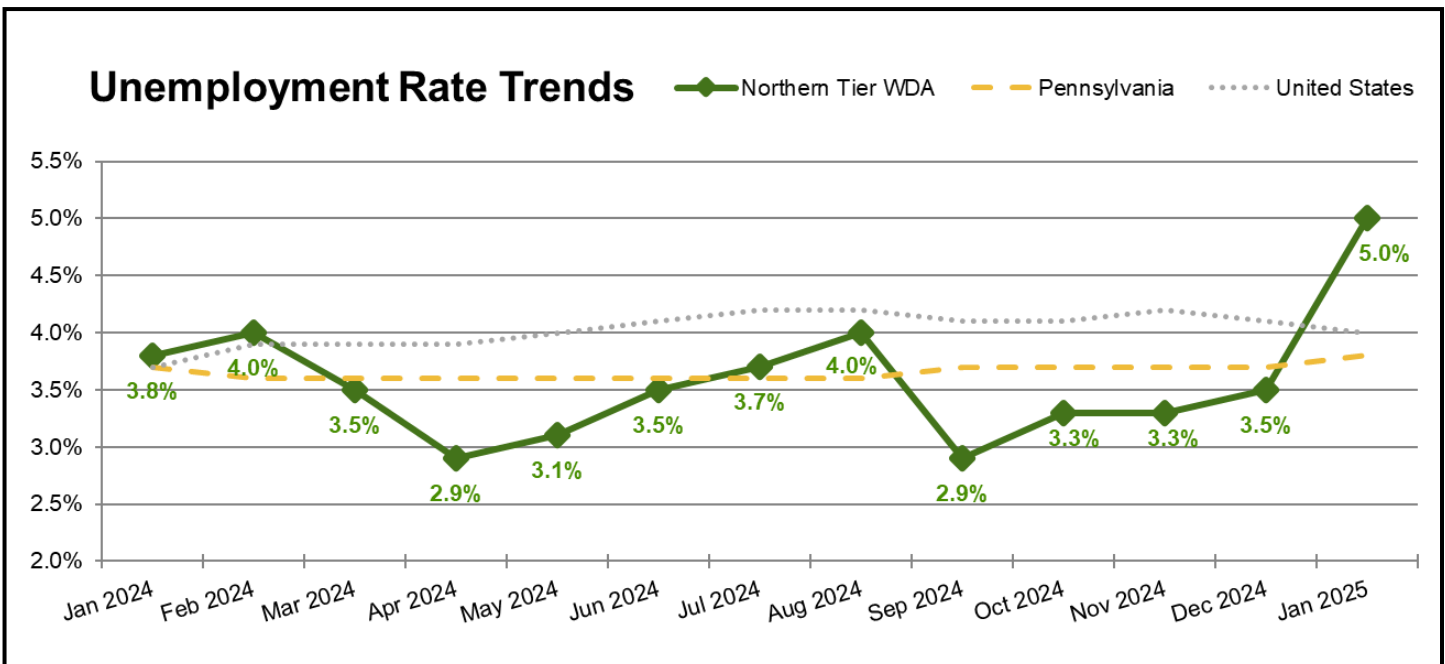
This report provides an overview of the labor market conditions in the Northern Tier Workforce Development Area (WDA). In January 2025, the labor force contracted while the employed population declined and the unemployed population grew, resulting in a higher unemployment rate compared to the previous month. **Please note that the labor market data in this report is not seasonally adjusted, and the 2024 historical data has been revised as part of the annual benchmarking process.**
