

Northern Tier WDA Labor Market Report ♦ April 2025

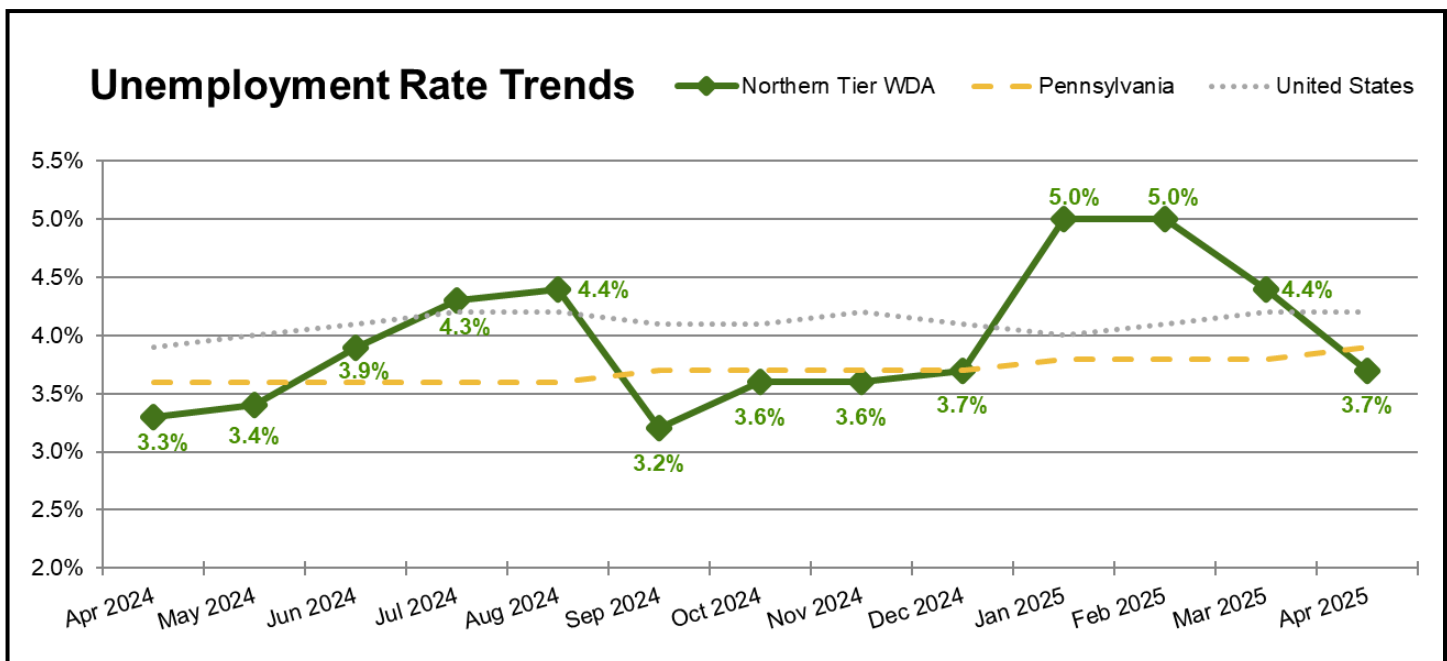
This report provides an overview of the labor market conditions in the Northern Tier Workforce Development Area (WDA). In April 2025, the labor force size remained unchanged, but a rise in employment and a decline in unemployment led to a lower unemployment rate compared to the previous month. **Please note the local labor market data in this report is not seasonally adjusted while state and national data are seasonally adjusted. Additionally, all 2024 historical data has been revised as part of the annual benchmarking process.**
