Grant Spotlight: Recent Awards Strengthening Our Communities

With assistance from the Northern Tier Regional Planning and Development Commission, communities across the region recently secured **\$1,362,130.00** in grant funding to support tourism, public safety, infrastructure, recreation, and essential human services.

Key awards include **BCTPA Room Tax grants** supporting heritage tourism through the Sayre Historical Society and America250PA Bradford County's 2026 Semiquincentennial celebration; **CFA Local Share Account Statewide funding** for projects such as municipal vehicles, equipment, generators, infrastructure modernization, and recreational improvements in Forest Lake Township, Lake Winola Fire Company, Liberty Township, Meshoppen Township, Middletown Township, Montrose Borough, Morris Township, Richmond Township Municipal Authority, and Springville Township; **DCED Greenways, Trails and Recreation funding** for Ervin Kaminski Park improvements in Gibson Township; and **DCED Neighborhood Assistance Program awards** supporting the Rialto Theatre's community programming and the expansion of Susquehanna County Interfaith's human services hub.

Together, these investments reflect a strong commitment to community vitality, economic development, and quality-of-life improvements throughout the region.

Twin Tiers ARISE Program (TTAP)



For the last 2 years, six partners in the Twin Tiers have worked to improve youth-workforce integration through a [\\$4.5 million dollar grant](#) awarded by the Appalachian Regional Commission. Continued employer input is absolutely vital to this effort.

The county has been awarded a \$2 million DCED Multimodal Transportation Fund grant through PennDOT to support the replacement of the bridge at Salt Springs State Park. This vital bridge serves as the park's main entrance and is essential to ensuring safe, reliable access for the thousands of visitors who enjoy the park year-round.

The award reflects PennDOT's competitive selection process, which evaluates projects based on safety improvements, regional economic impact, technical and financial feasibility, job creation, energy efficiency, and long-term operational sustainability. This significant investment will help preserve and enhance one of the county's most treasured natural destinations for years to come.
